



Musings from the manse

This is the time of the year when the words of Psalm 96 seem to come to pass, at least in this country:

Let the heavens rejoice, let the earth be glad; let the sea resound, and all that is in it.

Let the fields be jubilant, and everything in them; let all the trees of the forest sing for joy.

Let all creation rejoice before the Lord ... (Psalm 96:11-13a)

The earliest Christians often talked of the two books of God, the Book of Scripture and the Book of Nature as being God's revelation to us. We, though, often major in one and neglect the other.

Jesus continually used the world around him to open up people's minds to the truths of the kingdom. Seeds. Sheep. Birds of the air. Flowers of the field. Wheat and tares.
