#### musings from the manse

Leaves to rake, summer plants to cut back, the autumn garden rituals are upon us. They may feel laborious, we may feel reluctant to go out in the cold and the damp to do them. But they are necessary in order for the flourishing and fruitfulness of that green space the next spring and summer.

Jesus says in John's gospel, 'I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful.' (John 15:1-2) It is not only our gardens that need some seasonal maintenance but also our lives of faith. Our life in Christ needs an autumnal, or any season, clean up.

This though is not something that we do. This is not a self-pruning, but a God pruning. We are the garden and God is the gardener.

We need to be willing to allow God to come and act in our life to 'prune us.' Through his Spirit challenge us to stop doing things, start doing things, transform behaviours and attitudes. We need to surrender to God for this to happen. Be willing to be formed by God into something new, something better.

This autumn find some time, maybe when you are out in the garden, and ask God to come and work in your life to 'prune' your faith so you are shaped more in the likeness of Jesus and so that in the seasons to come you will be ever more fruitful.
