musings from the manse

We have now moved past the point where there is more darkness in the day than light with the autumn equinox behind us, and with the clocks falling backwards on the 27th October we find the darkness appearing earlier each day. There are many who dread this time of year. I knew someone who hated the day after midsummer's day because he knew from that point on there would be less daylight for the next six months.
